- Residents walking to the site should line up along Washington Street.
- Food boxes weigh about 35 pounds; walk ups encouraged to bring their own cart.
- Residents walking to the site are **REQUIRED** to wear face coverings and practice social distancing. Anyone not wearing a mask will not be allowed to enter the site.
- No arrivals before 10 a.m.
- **1,000 boxes to be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.**
