IV. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

The Board allowed time for members of the public to comment on the budget.

V. DISCUSSION BY BSE MEMBERS REGARDING 2011-2012 BUDGET

Mrs. Grill stated that they had a meeting with the MEA about how to address the issue with the aides. She stated that they began with outsourcing Para-Professionals to the Essex County Commission who will place them in various schools. However, a number of concerns were heard throughout the Montclair Community. The negotiating committee of the Board along with Dr. Patterson drafted a proposal that would address come of the concerns. She indicated that they created a way to maintain para-professionals in district, benefits to be continued for those with 20 or more years, they increased the pay rates which are competitive hourly rates, and maintained the savings in the budget. Ms. Grill stated that they came up with a fair agreement. The Board will approve it on Monday, April 11 and he MEA will look at it on Tuesday.

Mrs. Lombard clarified that the agreement has not yet been approved by the Board or the members of the MEA and will not impact the budget.

Dr. Baskerville spoke about her concerns with Ms. Grill's statement about other districts being successful in outsourcing para-professionals. She stated that it is somewhat shortsighted to balance a budget on health benefits. While health benefits may save money in the district this year, the national studies demonstrate that the district is costing the State of New Jersey more money by not providing health benefits. She stated that she is not in favor of trying to balance this budget by not providing health benefits for any family. She stated that there is a lot of staff that work far beyond part-time and are not being compensated.

Mr. Murnick expressed his concerns about the budget that is very responsible and satisfying to the community along with educating the children and ensuring there safety in buildings well maintained. He commended the Board and the MEA for their proposals in order to stay within the budget to provide a quality education to the children. He concluded that he hopes the Board moves forward on the Pre–K discussions.

Mayor Fried thanked members of the Board of School Estimate, Board of Education, and Dr. Alvarez, and Mrs. Sullivan for their hard work. This years' budget is a responsible one which preserves the quality of education and focuses on the outcome for the children. Reasonable decisions were made by professionals and Board of Education members. He concluded that the most important values were upheld and examined which laid the foundation for a successful process this year and going forward.
