3. Resolution Re: Approval of Withdrawal of Funds From Maintenance Reserve in the 2017-2018 Budget

District Wide: Fire alarm & sprinkler system repairs

Edgemont: Renovations to the library, including but not limited to painting and plaster repairs, replacement of window shades, carpet, and entrance doors

George Inness Annex: Girls' locker room, boys' locker room and stairwell plaster repairs and painting and compressor replacement

High School: Wrestling room door replacement and installation/replacement of the air filtration in the carpentry room

Hillside: Replacement of flooring (carpet, mastic and/or VAT) in various rooms and sanding/refinishing of wood floors

Nishuane: Landscaping at the front of the school, installation of ceiling drops and replace the sidewalk along Cedar Avenue

Renaissance: Installation of wireless clocks

Watchung: Repair of piping in tunnel and possible underground return line replacement

Woodman Field: Replacement of the drinking fountains at the baseball field and repair of natural gas line leak

6. Agenda Title: Extension of Contract for Custodial Cleaning 2017-2018 School Year

Topic: Supplies, equipment and services anticipated to be in excess of \$40,000 are subject to the bidding requirements of New Jersey Statutes 18A:18A-4 or are to be purchased under a State of New Jersey contract through the provisions of N.J.S. 18A:18A-10.

Background Information: In accordance with Public School Contract Law, specifications were prepared, advertised, and sealed bids received on May 21, 2015, for Custodial Cleaning for the 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 school years, with an option to renew for 2017-2018. A contract was awarded to Pritchard Industries, 147 Columbia Turnpike, Florham Park, New Jersey, 07932, who has offered to renew their contract for 2017-2018 at the current 2.75% CPI rate as allowable in the contract for a total amount of \$635,656.27.

Superintendent's Recommendations: Since the service supplied by the low bidder continues to meet the original specifications, I recommend that the Montclair Board of Education exercises its authority to extend the contract for Custodial Cleaning to Pritchard Industries for the school year 2014-2015 at the terms and conditions set forth therein.

WHEREAS, the Hopatcong Board of Education is willing to provide the services to coordinate transportation for the above-referred-to Boards of Education for transportation to special education, private, vocational-technical, and other school students to specific destinations in order to attempt to achieve the maximum cost effectiveness;

WHEREAS, the Hopatcong Board of Education shall provide such services under the name of "Sussex County Regional Transportation Cooperative."

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Montclair Board of Education that pursuant hereto the President and Secretary of the Montclair Board of Education are hereby authorized and directed to execute a duplicate of the Resolution which shall act as an agreement between the Montclair Board of Education and the Sussex County Regional Transportation Cooperative for the coordination of transportation of public school students to their specific destinations upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The Montclair Board of Education shall pay to the Sussex County Regional Transportation Cooperative in consideration of the services it shall render pursuant to this agreement an amount to equal two percent (2.0%) of the Montclair Board of Education's actual cost paid for transportation of public school students to specific destinations during the 2017 - 2018 school year, said sum to be paid as follows in each year during the term of this agreement or any extension hereof.

All services will be invoiced on a monthly basis September – June.

*All 2017 summer routes shall be billed upon completion of transportation.

2. The Sussex County Regional Transportation Cooperative will provide the following services:

a. routes coordinated with other districts to attempt to achieve a maximum cost reduction while maintaining a realistic capacity and travel time (see "Attachment A" for cost calculations);

b. statements prepared on appropriate vouchers according to the above schedule delineating costs per route;

- c. computer print-outs of student lists for all routes coordinated by the Sussex County Regional Transportation Cooperative for DRTRS reporting deadlines;
 - d. all necessary interaction and communication between the sending district, receiving school, and the respective transportation contractors;
 - e. timely review and revision of routes;
 - f. provide transportation within three days or sooner after receipt of the formal written request;
 - g. timely submission of contracts, renewals or addenda to the county office for approval.
3. The Montclair Board of Education will provide the Sussex County Regional Transportation Cooperative with the following:
- a. requests for any public students on approved forms to be provided by the Sussex County Regional Transportation Cooperative, completed in full and signed by Montclair Board of Education Secretary or other designated district personnel;
 - b. withdrawal for any public students on approved forms to be provided by the Sussex County Regional Transportation Cooperative, completed in full and signed by the Montclair Board of Education Secretary or other designated district personnel; no billing adjustment will be made without this completed form; and
 - c. strict adherence to the above payment schedule.
4. Additional Cost – all additional costs generated by unique requests, including but not limited to mid-day runs, early dismissals, change in number of children being transported on each route, or change in mileage during the year, will be borne by the Montclair Board of Education.
5. Length of Agreement – This agreement and obligations and requirements herein shall be in effect between July 1, 2017 and June 30, 2018.
6. It is a condition of this agreement that it shall automatically be renewed annually without amendment and may not be terminated without a notice by certified mail, return receipt requested having been delivered to the Secretary of either party hereto at least 180 days before June 30 of any year. In the event this agreement is renewed, the consideration to be paid to the Sussex County Regional Transportation Cooperative set forth in Paragraph 1 hereof, shall be revised to equal two percent (2.0%) of the Montclair Board of Education’s actual cost paid for transportation of public school students to specific destinations during the prior year.
7. The Hopatcong Board of Education under the name of Sussex County Regional Transportation Cooperative accepts no responsibility for a pupil’s use of arranged transportation or attendance on an established route. Once assigned to a route, the billing for the pupil’s reserved seat will continue until the Sussex County Regional Transportation Cooperative is otherwise noticed in writing to delete the pupil from the assigned route.
8. Entire Agreement – This agreement constitutes the entire and only agreement between the parties and may be amended by an instrument in writing over authorized signature.
9. It is a condition of this agreement that a representative from each applicable position: School Business Administrator/School Board Secretary, Special Services Director, and Transportation Supervisor attend at least one (1) Sussex County Regional Transportation Cooperative meeting on an annual basis to promote and provide effective and efficient transportation services.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Montclair Board of Education approves the attached job description for Social Worker II.

Qualifications:

1. Master's degree in social work, psychology, or or equivalent from an accredited university.
2. Experience in a school setting preferred; training staff on mental health topics preferred.
3. At least five years' experience and training in dealing with students with anxiety, depression, mental health counseling, ODD, school avoidance, and substance abuse disorders.
4. Ability to work effectively with staff, parents, and community members in a collaborative fashion.
5. Demonstrated ability to work harmoniously in a multicultural, diverse community.
6. Ability to work on site during the hours required including two evenings per month, flex hours and off site as needed.
7. Required criminal background check and proof of US citizenship or legal alien status.

Such alternatives to the above qualifications as the Superintendent may find appropriate and acceptable.

Responsible to: Superintendent or designee

Job Goal: Provide counseling services to meet the needs of students in grades 6 - 8 experiencing difficulty in school programs or settings. As a mental health professional, work with students and families to support them in order to build safeguards and structures that will allow them to improve their middle school experience.

Performance Responsibilities:

1. Provide therapeutic services to students and families in a coordinated setting with the school and community; both individual and group counseling services as well as family supports.
2. Coordinate programs and services with other school-based activities and community agencies.
3. Identify and plan appropriate strategies that will assist principals, guidance counselors and teachers in early intervention and student assistance techniques to enable students to remain in an educational setting with their peers.
4. Conduct intake interviews with students and families to assess their situation.
5. Observe student behavior to assess needs and create treatment strategies.
6. Work closely with teachers, administrators, and other staff to identify students in need and/or crisis.
7. Research and maintain contact with community social agencies concerned with school-age children or their families and make referrals for using these resources when appropriate.
8. Work within the parameters of I&RS, 504, and RtI when needed.
9. Collaborate with school staff to assess students' and families' needs, situations, strengths and weaknesses, and recommend support networks to encourage healthy emotional growth.
10. Develop plans to improve students' and families' wellbeing on an ongoing basis.
11. Conduct bi-weekly meetings with school administration and counselors detailing students' progress.
12. Assist in creating and building protocols for crisis management in direct relationship with the District Mental Health Coordinator.
13. Intervene when students are in danger of neglect or abuse by following Board policy and reporting procedures and providing means for follow-up.
14. Communicate on a regular basis through reporting, phone, email, and conferences with the families of students being treated.
15. Evaluate services provided on a regular basis to ensure that they are effective and make changes when necessary.
16. Ability to diagnose and treat mental, behavioral, and emotional issues.
17. Discuss and address individual student concerns including the discipline, suspension, exclusion or removal of a student from participating in extra-curricular activities.
18. Keep accurate and confidential records for all managed cases.
19. Maintain a system for reevaluating students who have exited the program to ascertain if support is still needed or students are doing well.
20. Maintain professional relationships with people, acting as a guide or advocate.
21. Assist with in-service training programs for school personnel (administrators, teachers, guidance counselors, etc) in managing students with emotional and behavioral problems.
22. Create a resource document for district teaching staff that highlights topics relevant to handling students at risk and include practical, real-life applications.
23. Assume other related responsibilities and duties within the context of the above, state law

and board policies.
