Current District Initiatives Accomplished

- Developed tutorial program in each building with afterschool busing provided at certain buildings
- Trained staff in cultural awareness and unconscious racism
- Worked with clergy groups to develop tutorial programs in our most needed areas
- Worked with community partners on coordinating and developing programs for our most needy students
- Reviewed K-5 data to develop a universal literacy and math program with staff/parent input
- Partnered with Montclair State University to assist us in our tutorial and staff development programs



Initiatives Accomplished cont'd.

- Contracted with <u>The People's Institute</u> to expose staff to *Undoing Racism*
- Developed a standardized discipline code in middle and high school to address student suspensions
- Developed a Guidance Handbook for parents to navigate our curricular offerings
- Reviewed our current Algebra placement and course offerings in middle and high school
- Reorganized our Title funds from staff salary allocations to program allocations
- Developed a minority staff recruitment program

- Reviewed the current registration process to ensure that our District has a diverse balance
- Worked with the Montclair Education Association's leadership to jointly develop a Professional Development program
- Assured that STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) is in every building in the District regardless of the building's magnet philosophy
- Implemented *Renaissance Learning*, an assessment tool in Math & ELA for Grades 2 8 in all schools
- Implemented *AVID*
