Parents/Guardians will be required to complete the Daily Covid Screening form in the Genesis Parent Access portal each day that their child will be attending school in person. The form will NOT be published to the portal if your child is remaining virtual or will not be expected to report in person on a particular day. The form will need to be completed for ALL of your children who are expected to attend in person. The Daily COVID Form will become available at midnight on the day your child is scheduled to report to school.

Symptoms

This confidential form must be submitted for each student every school day by 7:00 AM.

Any of the symptoms below could indicate a COVID-19 infection in children and may put your child at risk for spreading illness to others. Please note that this list does not include all possible symptoms and children with COVID-19 may experience any, all, or none of these symptoms. Please check your child daily for these symptoms

Section A - If TWO OR MORE of the fields in this Section are checked off, please keep your child home and contact your child's school. We recommend you contact your child's health care provider for further guidance.

- Chills
- Muscle Aches
- Headache
- Sore Throat
- Nausea or Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Congestion or runny nose

Section B - If AT LEAST ONE field in this Section is checked off, please keep your child home and contact your child's school. We recommend you contact your child's health care provider for further guidance.

- Fever (Temperature over 100)
- Cough
- Shortness of Breath
- Difficulty Breathing
- New loss of smell
- New loss of taste

Close Contact/Potential Exposure

If you have checked ANY boxes in this section, please keep your child home and contact your child's school. We recommend you contact your child's health care provider for further guidance.

Further instructions will be communicated from the school nurse.

Please verify if:

- My child has had a potential exposure (6 feet of a covid positive person for 15 minutes or more within a 24 hour period) with a person with confirmed or suspected COVID-19.
- My child or someone in my household is diagnosed with Covid-19, has been tested for, or is awaiting test results for suspected COVID-19/
- My child has traveled out of state or out of country within the last 10 days. Exceptions are: NY, CT, PA, DE.
